

COMMUNIQUE

The Board of Directors (the "**Board**") of MCB Group Limited (the "**Company**") wishes to inform its shareholders and the investing public in general of the following:

SCRIP DIVIDEND

Further to the Communiqué issued on the 13th June 2025, the Board has approved the issue of 1,945,941 Ordinary Shares, under the terms of the Scrip Dividend Scheme and the related Circular, for a total consideration of Rs. 818,793,594.57 to shareholders who have opted for Scrip Shares in respect of the dividend declaration on the Company's Ordinary Shares dated 14th May 2025.

GROUP EMPLOYEE SHARE OPTION SCHEME

Following the offering of 922,476 options to employees under the Group Employee Share Option Scheme in October 2024, a total of 18,316 options were exercised during the third transfer window of the scheme, for a total consideration of Rs. 7,765,984.00. The balance of 632,438 options will lapse around the 15th October 2025.

CONVERSION OF PREFERENCE SHARES INTO ORDINARY SHARES

Further to the Communiqué issued on 9th June 2025, the Company has received requests from holders of Preference Shares to convert an aggregate of 6,448,633 Preference Shares into Ordinary Shares. In this context, the Board has approved the issue of 146,627 Ordinary Shares of the Company for a total consideration of Rs. 64,480,689.52.

ISSUE AND LISTING OF THE NEW ORDINARY SHARES

As a result of the above transactions, a total of 2,110,884 new Ordinary Shares have been issued on 9^{th} July 2025 by the Company for listing on the Stock Exchange of Mauritius Ltd and shall be available for trading on 10^{th} July 2025. The number of Ordinary Shares in issue now stands at 261,534,755.
